

Windows PDA Microsoft Daylight Savings Time (DST) Patch

The following will walk you through installing the Microsoft DST patch on PDA's with Windows Mobile 2003 or 5.0 installed..

This Microsoft patch will have to be applied to every PDA that is located in any country affected by the Energy Policy Act of 2005, which is taking effect for the first time upon March 11, 2007. Please verify that this patch is installed by following the instructions below to install the patch manually.

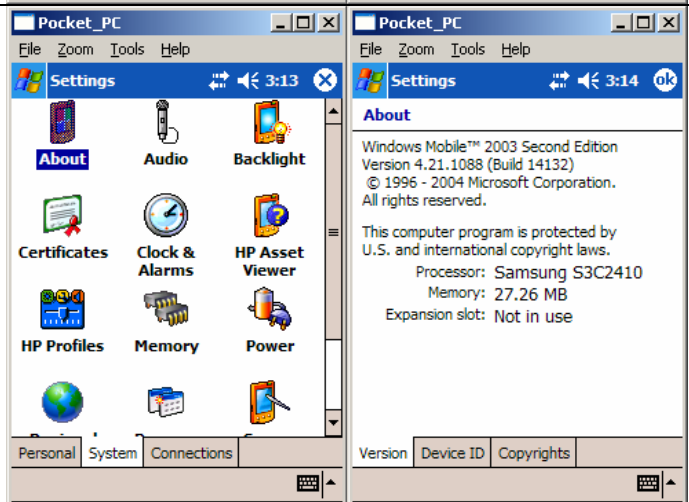
To determine which patch to apply to your Windows Mobile Device you will first need to know what version of Windows Mobile your PDA is running.

Click on the Start button on your PDA screen, select settings, and then select the system tab at the bottom of the screen.



Once in the System tab find and double click upon the About icon on your PDA. A new screen should appear that lists the Windows Mobile Version that the PDA is Running.

Note: Microsoft has chosen to only release patches for Windows Mobile 2003, and Windows Mobile 5.0. If your PDA is not running one of these operating systems you can not use these instructions to upgrade your device to be compatible with the new Daylight Savings Time dates.

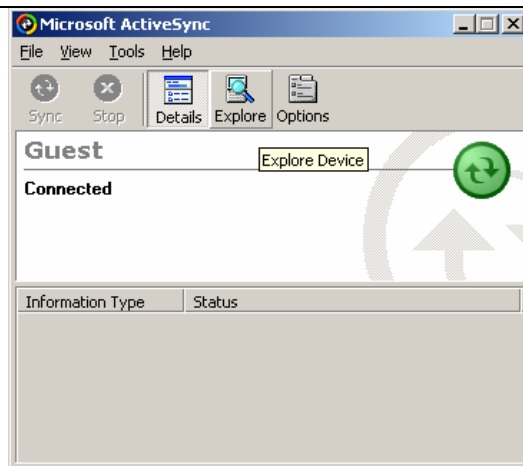


After you determine the version of Windows Mobile that you have, you will need to download the correct patch for that version. The Links on the page you downloaded this guide from will provide the files you need; alternately you may go to: <http://www.microsoft.com/windowsmobile/daylightsaving/daylightdownload.msp> and download the correct files directly from Microsoft, you may also download them from our website at www.bestaccess.com under the Basis G, Basis V, and NT500 Transport DST Page.

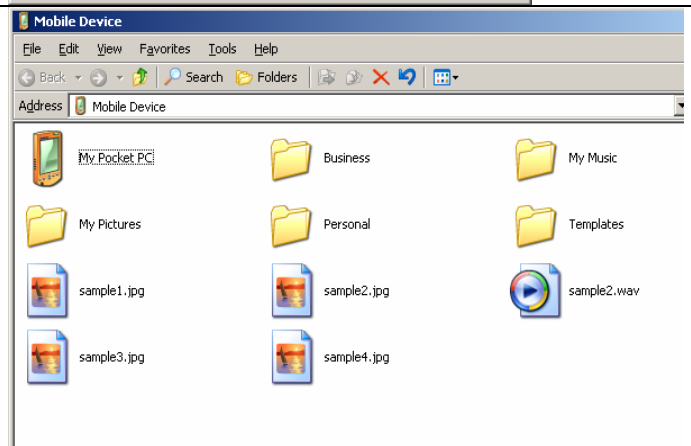
Once you have the file downloaded (and unzipped if necessary), you will need to Connect your PDA to your computer. Once it is connected, verify that ActiveSync has started and is synchronized and connected with your PDA.

After ActiveSync is fully synchronized, click on the Explore Icon in the toolbar in ActiveSync.



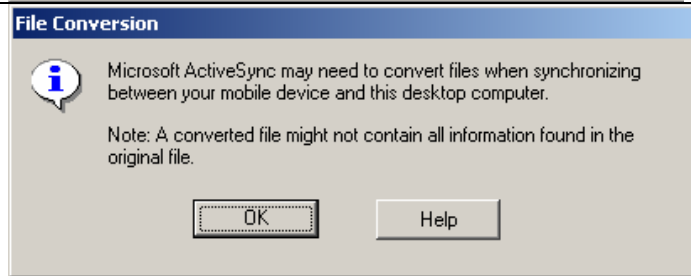
A file explorer window will open showing contents if the My Documents folder in the PDA device.

Drag and drop the file you saved (and unzipped) from the above steps over into the windows that opened for the pocket PC device.

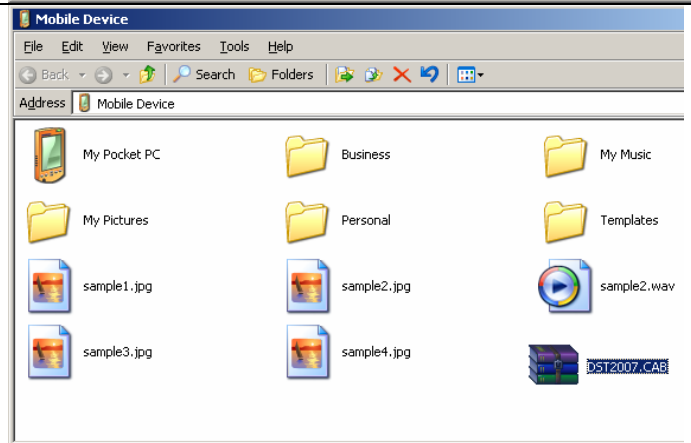


When you drag and drop the *.CAB file to the PDA, you may see the follow warning.

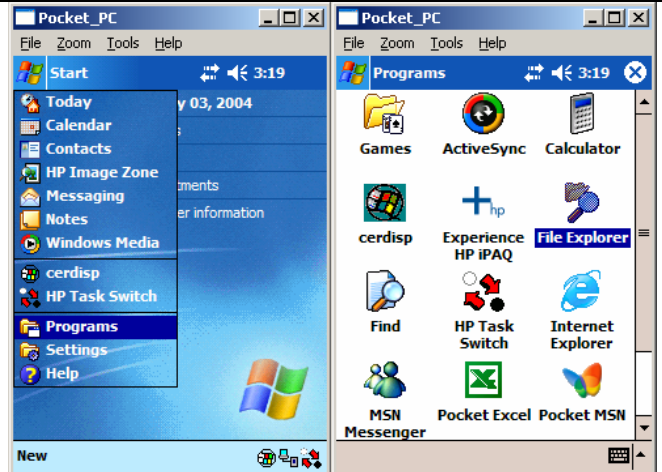
Just click upon the OK box, this is a normal error message that displays when directly coping files to the PDA.



You should now see the *.CAB file located in your Mobile Device explorer window.



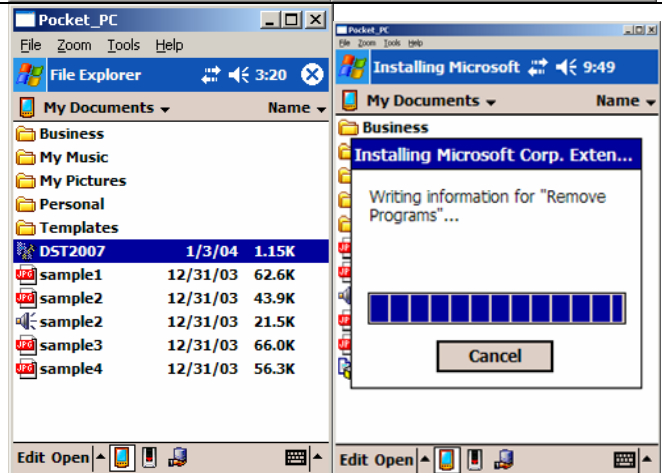
On the PDA, click on Start, then Programs, and then on the File Explorer Icon.



In the File Explorer Windows find the *.CAB file and double click upon it.

Once the DST patch has finished installing, to finish updating the Daylight Saving Time settings on the PDA, you must manually change the time zone on your device.

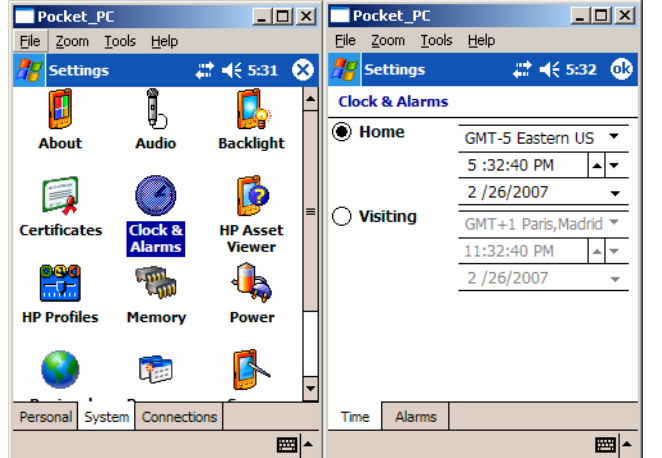
To properly update the Daylight Saving Time settings, you need to manually change the time zone on your device to another time zone, and then back to the time zone you are located in.



Click upon the start button, and then on settings. Select the system tab from the bottom of the screen.

Find the Clock & Alarms icon and double click upon it.

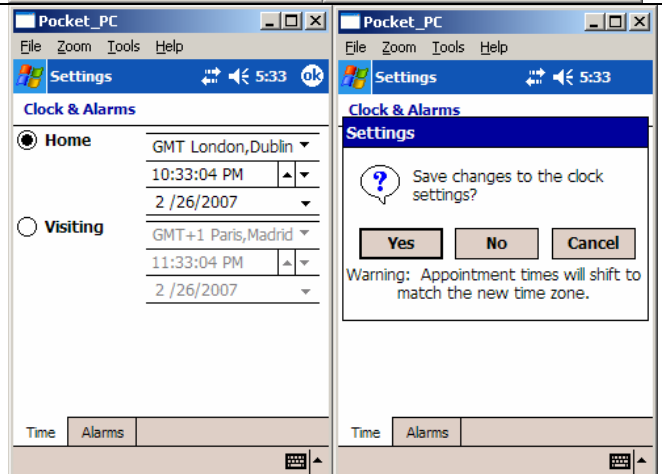
Click on the Home Radio Button and then click on the pulldown next to the current time zone that is selected on the PDA.



Change the current time zone under home to any time zone other than the one that is currently selected.

Click on OK.

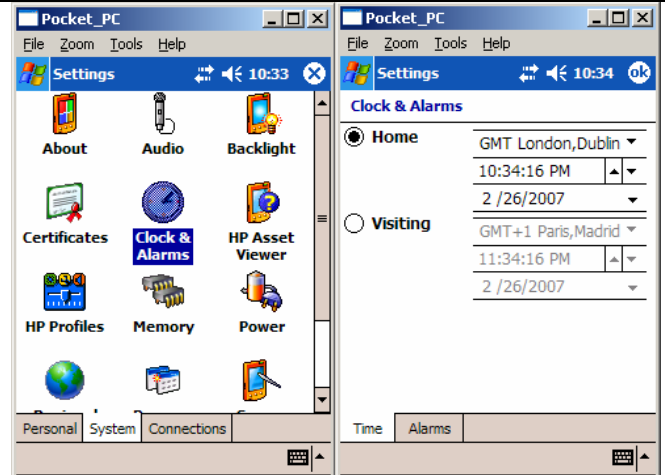
A Dialog box will appear asking you to Save changes to the clock settings. Click upon the Yes button.



Once again click upon the start button, and then on settings. Select the system tab from the bottom of the screen.

Find the Clock & Alarms icon and double click upon it.

Click on the Home Radio Button and then click on the pulldown next to the current time zone that is selected on the PDA.

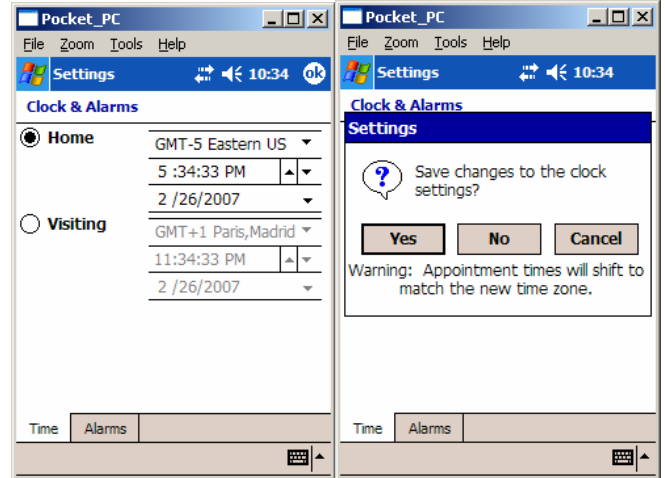


Change the current time zone under home to the time zone that you are located in and wish to use.

Click on OK.

A Dialog box will appear asking you to Save changes to the clock settings. Click Yes Here.

The Daylight Savings Patch has now been installed upon the PDA.



NOTE: This Patch is stored in volatile memory on the PDA; meaning that it is not a permanent fix for Daylight Savings Time upon PDA devices. If your PDA device ever goes through a “hard reset” this patch will have to be reapplied to the PDA afterwards. Hard resets may be caused by a number of things, such as a dead main and backup battery, or a memory corruption; they may even be manually initiated by a combination of button presses on many PDA models. Please be certain that if a Hard Reset occurs upon your PDA device, that you re-install the correct patch from Microsoft to correct for the new Daylight Savings Time start and end dates.

Please be certain to apply the correct patch to EVERY machine that is running any of your software applications. Devices that must be upgraded include all servers, clients, Intelligent Video servers, video recorders, and other servers such as archive and database servers.
